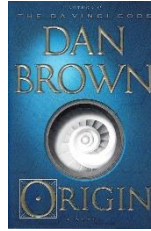

to see you there!



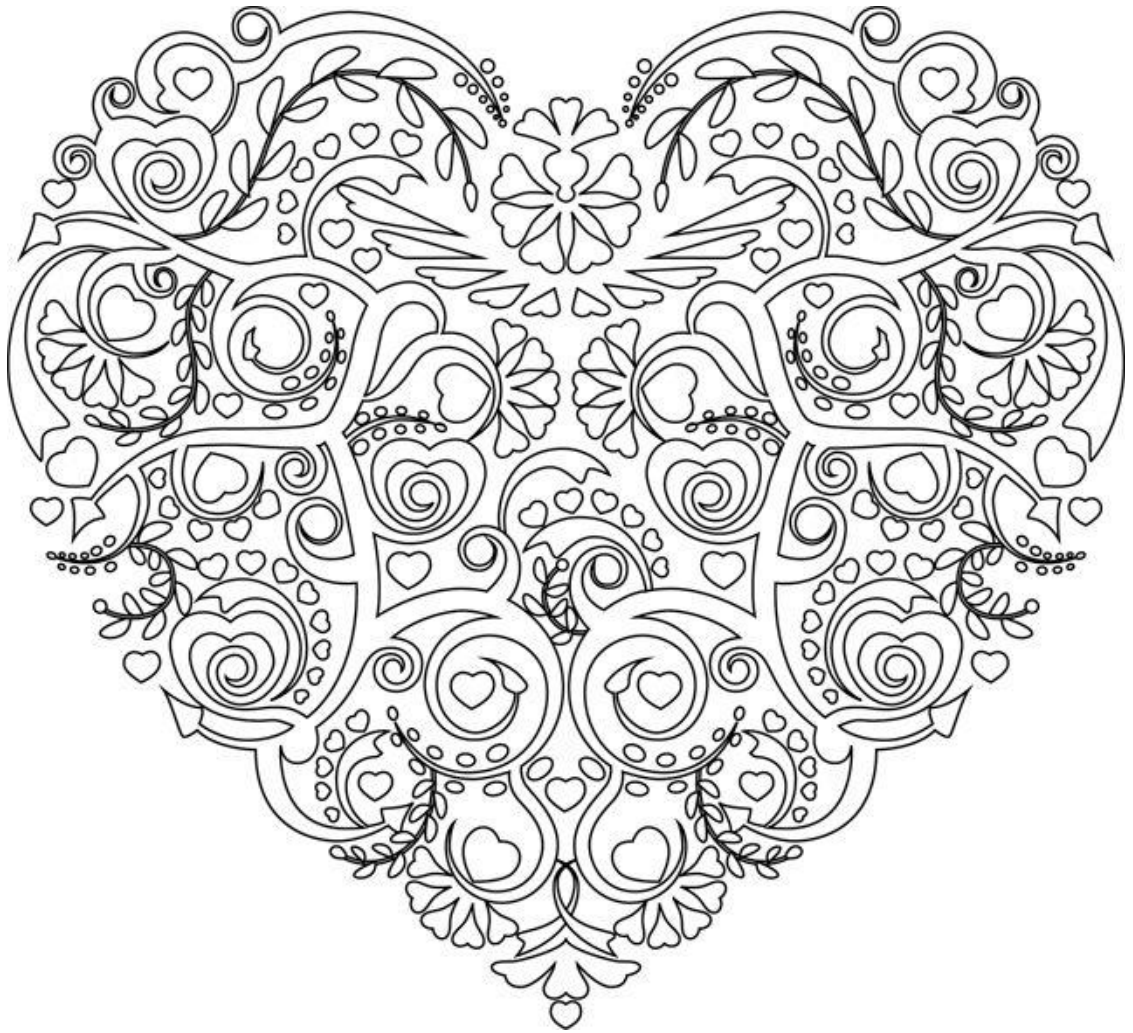
