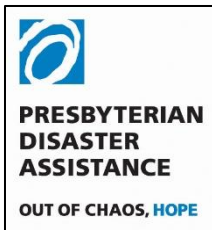

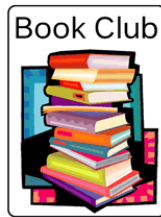


PDA is there to help.

Turn right onto Farm Rd 74

Turn left onto Farm Rd 171

Turn right onto Farm Rd 66

After about 2 miles you will turn right into the Fellows Lake marina area and follow this to the Pavilion.
